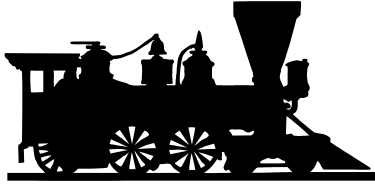
*Profits generated by the tea boxes help offset the Museum's operating costs and pay for educational programming and exhibits.*
