What are these plants taking over local habitats, my garden and yard?

Invasive plants are non-native species that show a tendency to spread out of control. The introduction of invasive species can cause economic or environmental harm, or can even harm human health. They compete with native plants for water, light, nutrients, and space. Invasive species contribute to the decline of 42% of the U.S. endangered and threatened species. They degrade wildlife habitats and water quality, increase soil erosion, and displace native food sources for wildlife.
